Vietjet takes delivery of its first Boeing aircraft – a milestone marking 30 years of Vietnam-U.S. relations



On September 21, 2025, Vietjet is celebrating its first Boeing 737-8 aircraft from the airline's landmark order of 200 jets valued at US\$32 billion with Boeing, the world's leading aircraft manufacturer. The ceremony took place with full honors at Boeing's Delivery Center in Seattle, Washington, attended by Vietnam's President Luong Cuong, senior officials from both nations, and key business partners.

The event marks both a major milestone in the growing partnership between Vietjet and Boeing and a powerful symbol of the Comprehensive Strategic Partnership between the two nations driving trade, investment, and creating hundreds of thousands of jobs in the U.S. The new aircraft, along with hundreds more to be delivered in the

coming years, will be deployed on Vietjet's high-demand regional routes, enhancing the travel experience for millions of passengers. It also underscores Vietjet's commitment to expanding its international network, while contributing to the sustainable development of the aviation industry regionally and globally.

Vietjet strengthens international cooperation at MRO Asia-Pacific 2025



On September 17-18, a Vietjet delegation attended the MRO Asia-Pacific 2025 exhibition in Singapore. The delegation included Dr. Nguyen Thanh Hung and Mr. Tommy Nguyen, Strategic Assistant to the Chairman. This year's event marked its 25th anniversary, gathering more than 6,000 aviation experts and 300 international suppliers, reaffirming its role as

the region's leading and most reputable field in the aircraft Maintenance, Repair, and Overhaul (MRO). Within the framework of the exhibition, the delegation held meetings with many strategic partners such as Airbus, Boeing Global Services, Global Engine Maintenance (GEM), Regent Aerospace, Pratt & Whitney, CFM, and more.

* From December 1, passengers will complete end-to-end procedures (ticket purchase, check-in, security screening, boarding) through biometric technology linked with the VNedID e-identification system or via self-service kiosks at airports.

* The Ministry of Construction has decided to temporarily close Ca Mau Airport for one year to upgrade its facilities.

Vietjet welcomes new wide-body aircraft, expanding fleet to 121



On September 14, Vietjet has officially welcomed a new wide-body A330 aircraft with registration VN-A820, bringing the airline's total fleet to 121 aircraft, including those operated by Vietjet Thailand and Vietjet Kazakhstan.

This marks a significant milestone, affirming Vietjet's sustainable growth capacity in its global network expansion strategy, ready to meet the travel demands of the year-end peak season.

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On September 19, Vietjet, in collaboration with the Australian Border Force, organized a training course on "Document examination and handling skills for flights to and from Australia" for Vietjet employees.

The session was led by Ms. Sarah Zacka – First Secretary of the Australian Border Force, Australian Embassy in Bangkok. The training provided updates on the latest travel document regulations and equipped staff with skills to identify and handle related situations, thereby enhancing professional capacity, ensuring safety and security, and delivering greater convenience for passengers.

Vietjet accompanies Hanoi to promote tourism in India

Vietjet welcomed 22 and worked with experts from the International Air Transport Association (IATA) during the ISAGO (IATA Safety Audit for Ground Operations) audit at Noi Bai International Airport. Throughout the audit, IATA experts conducted
