Vietjet and Airbus strengthen strategic cooperation



In January, a Vietjet delegation led by BOD Member, Vice President - CFO Ho Ngoc Yen Phuong, visited and worked with Airbus leaders in Toulouse, France. During the meeting, both sides reviewed the progress of signed aircraft orders and agreed on solutions to accelerate the delivery schedule of the fleet, optimize operational efficiency, and promote sustainable development. The meeting further affirmed the strategic, sustainable, and long-term partnership between Vietjet and Airbus.

The delegation toured the A330neo-900 production line. The first A330s, out of a total of 40 ordered aircraft, will be delivered from 2026, marking a significant step in expanding Vietjet's flight network to Europe and the US, while also supporting its goal of becoming a Hybrid airline and upgrading its Business and Premium class services.

2025 Safety and quality review conference and 2026 action plan



On January 28, the 'Safety and quality management review 2025 and action plan for 2026' was held, chaired by Chairwoman - Dr. Nguyen Thi Phuong Thao, Managing Director - Chairman of the Safety Committee Nguyen Thanh Son, and Standing Vice President To Viet Thang, along with representatives from various units and departments throughout the company.

The Conference also listened to reports and discussions from the Safety and Quality Committee, along with representatives from relevant units and departments. The company's leadership commended the units and departments that excelled in safety and quality management in 2025.

The conference concluded with strong consensus and determination throughout the company to maintain and ensure safety and quality, affirm Vietjet's position and brand image, and meet the needs of customers both domestically and internationally, especially during the peak Tet (Lunar New Year) season in 2026.

Comac leaders visit and work with Vietjet



On January 30, Managing Director Nguyen Thanh Son welcomed and worked with Mr. Tan Wangeng, Vice President of Commercial Aircraft Corporation of China (COMAC), and his delegation. During the meeting, Mr. Tan Wangeng extended New Year greetings to the leadership and staff of Vietjet. Both sides reviewed and discussed ongoing cooperation, particularly the operation of the COMAC C909 (ARJ21) aircraft on Con Dao routes, laying the groundwork for further cooperation and expansion in the future.

AVIATION NEWS

* The Civil Aviation Authority of Vietnam is coordinating with airlines to continue increasing capacity on high-demand routes in order to meet travel demand during the Lunar New Year holiday.

* The Ministry of Construction has approved the task of formulating the Master Plan for Dong Hoi Airport and Dien Bien Airport for the 2021–2030 period, with a vision to 2050; The Civil Aviation Authority of Vietnam has submitted the planning dossier of Da Nang International Airport for the 2021–2030 period, with a vision to 2050, to the Ministry of Construction for appraisal and approval.

* Airports are implementing measures to strengthen the prevention and control of diseases caused by the Nipah virus, ensuring the safety of aviation staff and passengers traveling by air.

* Noi Bai International Airport is piloting a digital information lookup and wayfinding system, enabling passengers to quickly find flight details and navigate to boarding gates.

Q4 revenue up 47%, Vietjet grows strongly, expands international network in 2025



Vietjet Aviation Joint Stock Company (HOSE: VJC) has announced its business results, recording an increase in revenue and profit in Q4 and the full year of 2025, affirming its flexible and effective operational capacity. This serves as the foundation for Vietjet to enter 2026 with breakthrough global strategies.

Effective operations, profit maintains sustainable growth momentum

According to the financial statements, in Q4/2025, revenue of Vietjet's Parent Company reached VND 29.035 trillion (approx. US\$1.11 billion), an YoY increase of 47% while cumulative revenue for the whole year was VND 81.426 trillion (approx. US\$3.13 billion), up by 14% YoY. The Parent Company's gross profit for the year was reported at VND 8.213 trillion (approx. US\$316.2 million) thanks to the expansion of the flight network and lower fuel costs over last year's.

Pre-tax profit of the Parent Company and consolidated pre-tax profit in Q4/2025 reached VND 475 billion (approx. US\$18.29 million) and VND 579 billion (approx. US\$22.3 million) respectively, rocketing by 93.4% and 436% YoY.

For the full year, the Parent Company's pre-tax and post-tax profit was recorded at VND 2.462 trillion (approx. US\$94.7 million) and VND 1.968 trillion (approx. US\$7.5 million), up 40.8% and 51.1% YoY, exceeding 121% of the 2025 plan.

In 2025, consolidated revenue reached VND 82.093 trillion (approx. US\$3.16 billion), an increase of 14% YoY. Consolidated pre-tax and post-tax profit was reported at VND 2.630 trillion (approx. US\$101.3 million) and VND 2.123 trillion (approx. US\$81.7 million), growing by 44.3% and 51.2% while exceeding 120% of the annual plan.

As of December 31, 2025, Vietjet's total assets reached VND 139.459 trillion (approx. US\$5.37 billion), the net debt/equity ratio was at 2.25 times and the liquidity ratio was 1.53 times, securing leading rates in the aviation industry. In 2025, Vietjet successfully issued 50 million shares, increasing equity by VND 5 trillion (approx. US\$192.6 million), contributing to enhancing business performance in the future.

During the year, Vietjet paid a total of VND 10.537 trillion (approx. US\$405.9 million) of direct and indirect taxes and fees.

Expanding flight network, leading growth

In Q4/2025, Vietjet transported more than 6.7 million passengers on 36,100 flights. For the full year, the airline transported 28.2 million passengers on 153,000 flights, witnessing a growth of 9% and 11.2% YoY respectively. Total cargo volume transported was reported at 113,923 tons. To date, Vietjet continues to maintain its leading position in the domestic and international markets in terms of passenger volume.

In 2025, the airline operated a total of 254 routes, including 52 domestic and 202 international routes, while opening 22 new routes to Central Asia and China.

Expanding international cooperation, investing in fleet, ground and technical services

Q4/2025 marked many important steps in the airline's long-term investment strategy. The airline received a total of 22 new aircraft, the largest fleet expansion since its establishment.

During the year, the airline signed a contract to buy 100 A321neo aircraft from Airbus; and another with Rolls-Royce for 92 Trent 7000 engines with maintenance services worth of USD 3.8 billion.

In December, Thai Vietjet received new Boeing aircraft, managing to increase the scale of the entire system's fleet ahead of 2026.

In 2025, Vietjet Aviation Academy (VJAA) trained more than 162,000 trainees with 15,198 courses; proactively training pilots, technical staff, ground operations staff and other professional positions to meet the increasing human resource demand of the airline and the aviation industry.

At Long Thanh International Airport, the airline marked the milestone of topping out the international standard technical hangar project and the first commercial flight to the new airport.

Diversifying customer experience at Tan Son Nhat

Constantly innovating, Vietjet continuously introduced advanced products and utilities such as Business ticket class, SkyJoy membership program, in-flight shopping services, along with digital solutions such as multi-channel booking and payment, and AI assistant Amy.

In Q4/2025, at Tan Son Nhat - the airport with the largest traffic in the country, Vietjet handled its own ground services for all domestic and international flights instead of outsourcing. Self-serving ground services at the two largest airports in the country helped increase the on-time performance rate and service quality.

At the same time, the airline expanded the domestic check-in area, while promoting the application of technology in operations: real-time flight operation monitoring, vehicle coordination, data management and implementation of biometrics – electronic identification. Vietjet was honored by Airline Ratings (the world's leading prestigious organization in evaluating aviation safety and quality) to be among Top 10 safest airlines in the world 2025 and Best Ultra Low-Cost Airline while also won the Sustainability Award 2025.

Vietjet was also honored by World Travel Awards as Asia's leading airline in Customer Experience, voted by Brand Finance in the Top most valuable airline brands in ASEAN 2025, Top 50 best listed companies in Vietnam 2025 by Forbes, and the Best Place to Work in Asia 2025 by HR Asia Magazine.

Confidently entering 2026

With strong business growth, an expanded fleet, deep international cooperation and consolidated operational capacity, Vietjet enters 2026 with a solid foundation to continue pursuing a strategy of sustainable growth and global expansion.

Vietjet nominated for Asia-Pacific Sustainable Development Award



On January 23, Vietjet was nominated for the MyAero 2025 Sustainability Award in the ESG & Sustainability Leadership category at the ASEAN 2025 Sustainable Aviation Fuel (SAF) Outlook Report Launch Conference. The award will be officially announced and presented on July 1st, 2026 in Malaysia, honoring airlines that are pioneers in implementing sustainable environmental, social, and governance standards.

Vietjet enters the 2026 Tet peak season with proactive spirit and high determination



Entering the peak season of the 2026 Lunar New Year, following the directives of the Managing Director, all units and departments have proactively reviewed and prepared sufficient human resources, and implemented comprehensive solutions with high determination to meet the sharply increasing travel demand of the people, ensuring safety, quality, and operational efficiency.

During the peak period from February 2 to March 3, 2026, Vietjet will offer an additional 390,000 seats, equivalent to nearly 1,800 flights, focusing on routes with high demand before Tet and the reverse after Tet, contributing to reducing transportation congestion and facilitating passenger travel.

All Vietjet domestic flights will check in at Hall A, Terminal 1, Tan Son Nhat Airport



Continuously expanding its operations to meet the convenient travel needs of residents and tourists, from January 13, 2026, all Vietjet domestic flights will move their check-in area to Hall A, Terminal 1, Tan Son Nhat International Airport, Ho Chi Minh City.

Previously, from December 13, 2025, Vietjet flights departing from Ho Chi Minh City to Thanh Hoa Airport had already moved their check-in to Hall A, Terminal 1. At Terminal 1, passengers flying with Vietjet will experience new, convenient services with modern technology applications in the check-in process, especially during the upcoming peak holiday season and the Lunar New Year 2026.

Vietjet Thailand debuts Boeing aircraft on international routes



On January 29, 2026, Vietjet Thailand officially launched its first international service operated by the Boeing 737-8, marking a significant milestone as the airline begins deploying Boeing aircraft alongside its long-standing and efficiently operated Airbus fleet. This launch represents a key step in Vietjet Thailand's strategy to diversify its modern, large-scale fleet and further advance sustainable development across Vietjet as a multinational aviation group.

Round-trip - Nha Trang route is connecting with seven Bangkok flights per week. Directly connected two dynamic tourism hubs of Thailand and Vietnam, the service is expected to significantly boost tourism, trade and investment between the two countries and across the Asia-Pacific region.

Fly directly to admire the scenery Mount Fuji with Vietjet's new Hanoi - Shizuoka route




Vietjet has officially opened ticket sales for the route Hanoi – Shizuoka, Japan, with three return flights per week on Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Sundays. The new route will launch to serve passengers from April 28, 2026, bringing the total number of Vietjet routes between Vietnam and Japan to 11.

The new route contributes to strengthening connectivity between Vietjet and Shizuoka, Japan – renowned for the majestic Mount Fuji, the Mishima Skywalk, the longest suspension bridge in Japan, vast green tea hills in Nihondaira and Makinohara, the famous Shimizu fishing port, as well as hot spring resorts (onsen) in Atami and Izu.
