# KEY HIGHLIGHTS

- ▼ Vietnam becomes a focal point of geopolitical factors, turning into an investment and economic hub, a global destination with visits from the heads of major countries including the US, China, the UK, Germany, Australia, India, Indonesia, etc.
- ★ Vietjet has been turning HCMC and Hanoi into international aviation hubs alongside Singapore, Taipei (Taiwan, China), Seoul (South Korea), etc.
- ▼ Vietjet celebrates 1 year of flights to Australia with 2 new routes, bringing the total to 7 routes; 10 years of flights to Singapore and South Korea, etc.
- ▼ Vietjet transported 13.1 million passengers in the first 6 months of 2024, an increase of 11% compared to the same period in 2023, including over 5.5 million international and charter passengers, up 52% from the same period.
- ★ Vietjet operated 149 routes in the first 6 months of 2024, including 38 domestic routes and 111 international routes, compared to 125 domestic and international routes in 2023.
- ★ The audited total revenue in the first 6 months of 2024 was USD 1,362 million, an increase of 15% compared to the same period in 2023.

- ★ Audited profit before tax for the first 6 months of 2024 reached USD 40 million, a 307% increase compared to USD 10 million in the first 6 months of 2023
- ★ The load factor was maintained at a high level of 87% in the first 6 months of 2024
- ★ Achieved the highest technical reliability of 99.7% among leading airlines in the Asia-Pacific region
- Currently, Vietjet is operating 85 Airbus aircraft, including 17 A320s, 61 A321s, and 7 A330s.
- ➤ Vietjet is one of the few LCCs in the world to successfully operate wide-body aircraft with intercontinental routes, connecting destinations in Vietnam with Australia, India, Kazakhstan, etc.
- Vietjet continues to be a connecting factor for localities, promoting economic recovery and development across regions.








#### Largest fleet in Vietnam




# Domestic and international market share reached 40.5% and 54.5%




# Number of flights increased by 6% in H1.2024 compared to H1.2023

# FLEET EXPANSION

- ★ As of June 30, 2024, Vietjet's fleet comprised 85 aircraft, including 17 Airbus A320s, 36 A321CEOs, **25** A321NEOs, and **7** A330s, with an average age of 7.2 years.
- ★ The fleet's seat configuration ranges from 180 to **377** seats and is designed to suit the business model of a new-age airline.
- ▼ Vietjet has ordered a total of 406 aircraft, including **206** Airbus and **200** Boeing planes.



# VietJet adopts a comprehensive fuel cost management program that includes:

- ➤ Vietjet and Safran Group signed a contract to provide solutions to optimize aircraft fuel consumption (SFCO2). The program's solutions include optimizing engine power, providing accurate information on passengers' weights on board and the amount of backup fuel, etc.
- ★ The SFCO2 program reduces fuel consumption and CO2 emissions by up to 20% while improving the efficiency of flight operations according to international standards.
- ➤ Vietjet has also coordinated with engine manufacturers to implement multiple programs to support technical management and fuel saving, etc.



#### Stringent safety and security standards

#### Well-trained and highly professional crew

- Training programs are approved by the CAAV and carried out by VietJet Aviation Academy (VIAA)
- VJAA Academy is IATA's training partner, creating a solid foundation for Vietjet's sustainable development goals.
- In 2023, VJAA Academy has trained nearly 100 thousand trainees with more than 6,000 training courses meeting international aviation standards.

- ★ The aircraft is equipped with the Instrument landing system ("ILS"), Global positioning system ("GPS"), and Traffic alert and collision avoidance system ("TCAS")
- In addition, Vietjet has continuously upgraded the onboard communication system as well as strictly managed the aircraft's technical specifications to ensure safe flight operations
- Aviation safety is always Vietjet's top goal. In 2023, its technical reliability reaches 99.72%.






# SOLID GROWTH IN ANCILLARY

★ The audited ancillary and cargo transportation revenue in passenger transportation activities in H1.2024 reached nearly USD 462 million, an increase of 16% compared to the first 6 months of 2023, and contributed 34% of total revenue.



# Ancillary revenue % of Total Revenue







## **EXCELLENT FINANCIAL PERFORMANCE**

- ★ Audited total revenue in 1H of 2024 reached USD 1,361 million, increased by 15% compared to the first six months of 2023, driven by a growth in passenger transportation revenue (+34%) and ancillary revenue (+16%)
- ★ Profit after tax increased by 511% from USD 5 million in the first six months of 2023 to USD 33 million in the first six months of 2024
- ★ Total assets as of June 30, 2024, reached USD 3,690 million
- ★ Equity increased by 8.3% from USD 610 million in 2023 to USD 661 million in the first half of 2024
- Cash and cash equivalents as of June 30, 2024, amounted to USD 201 million


#### **TOTAL REVENUE (USD mil.)**




#### TOTAL ASSETS (USD mil.)




#### **CURRENT ASSETS/ CURRENT LIABILITIES**




#### **NET DEBT/TOTAL EQUITY**
