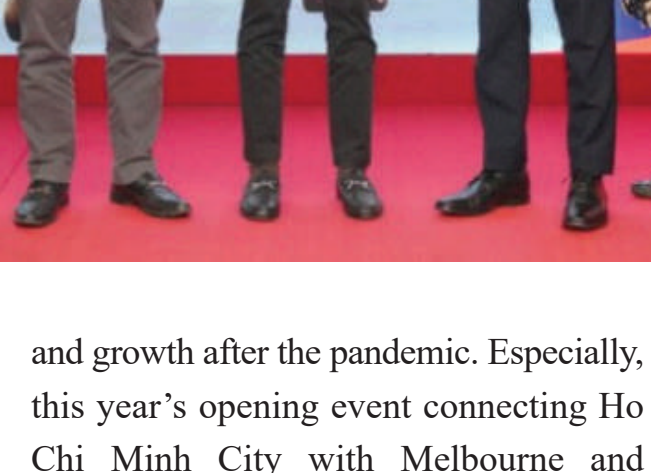

Urgent completion of special operations procedures for wide-body fleets



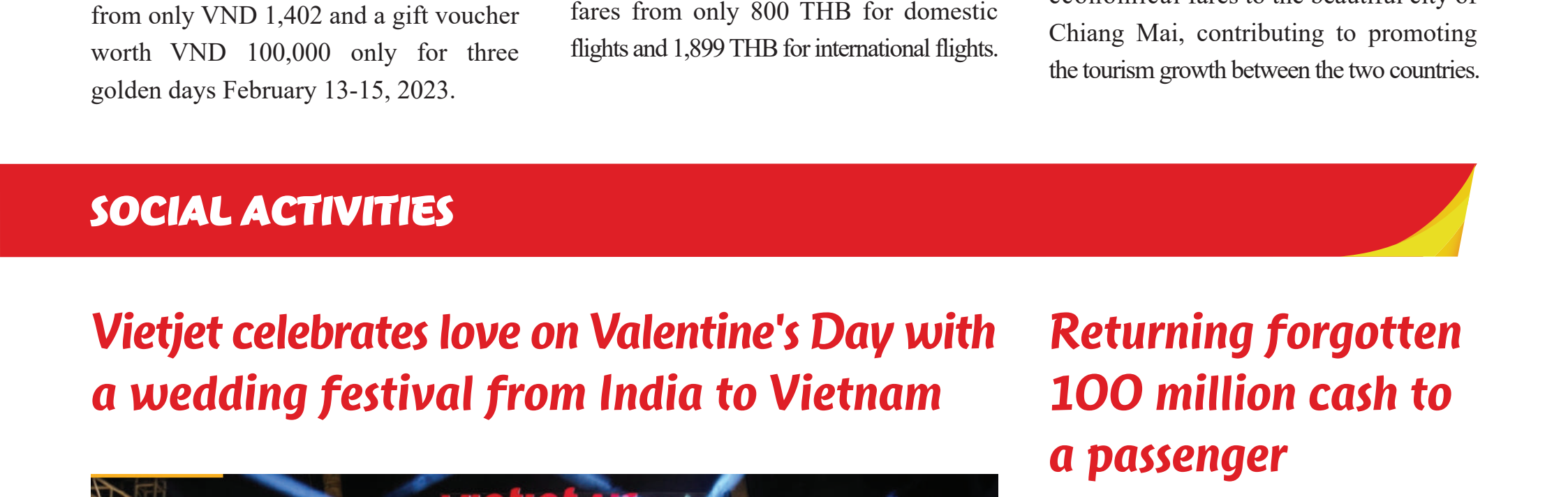
As part of the master plan to effectively operate the wide-body A330 fleet on routes to Australia and Europe in the near future, on February 15, Vietjet took the final steps of the approval process for the A330 fleet operating in low visibility weather conditions.

The test was witnessed by the heads of the Flight Crew, Safety and Quality Assurance Department and the Civil Aviation Administration of Vietnam (CAAV). After the test, CAAV assessed that Vietjet had fully met the actual requirements of the operation. Test flight will be conducted in a SIM before Vietjet's official approval.
