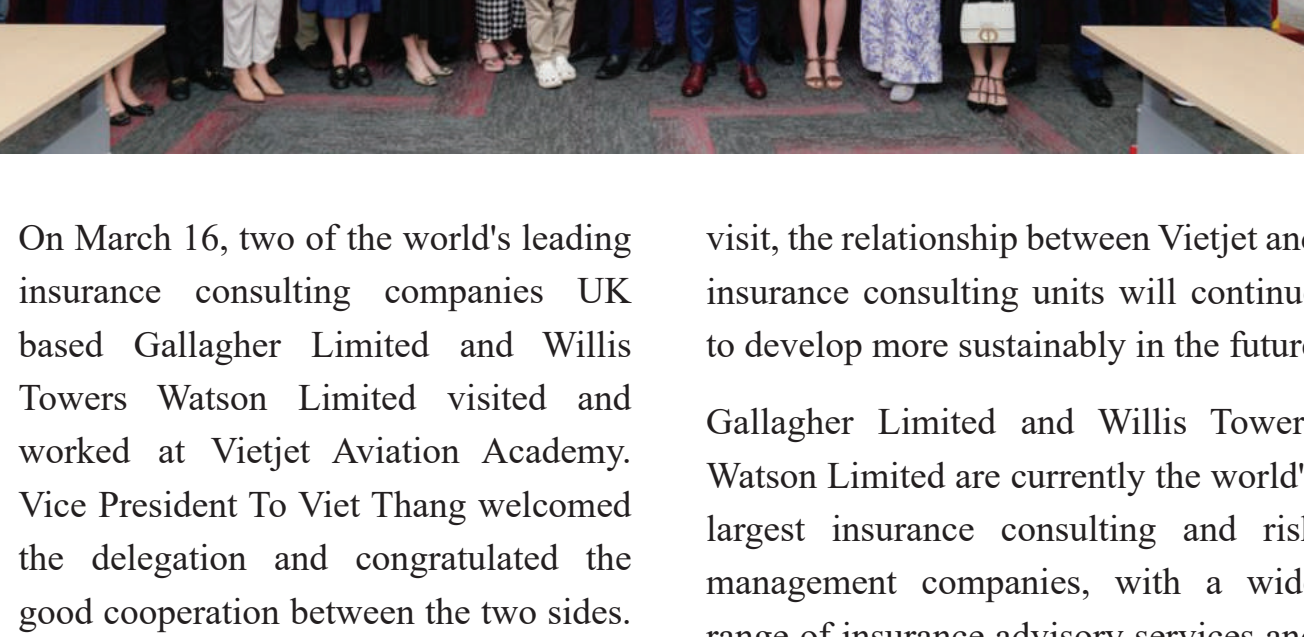

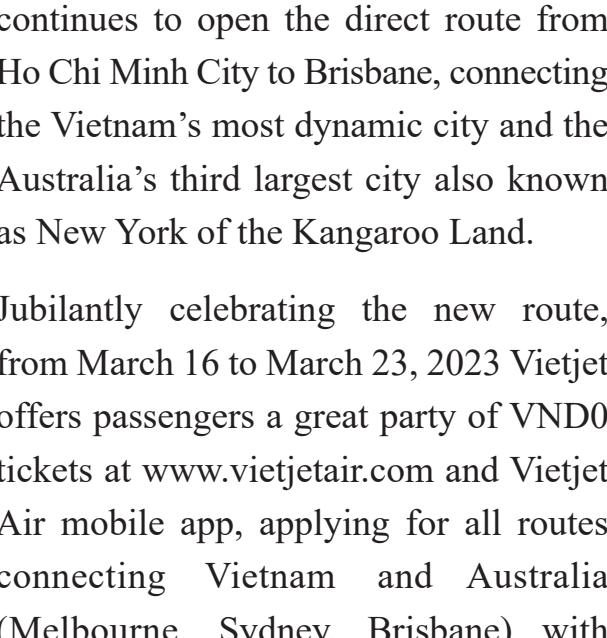
Bringing the dream of conquering the sky closer to young people

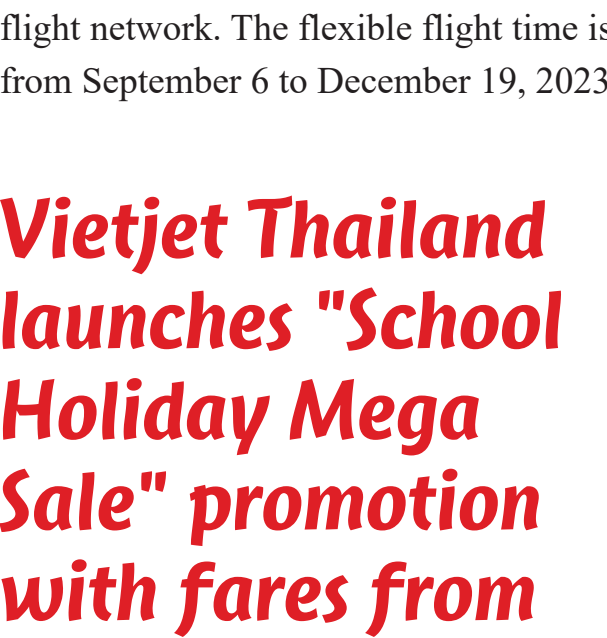
