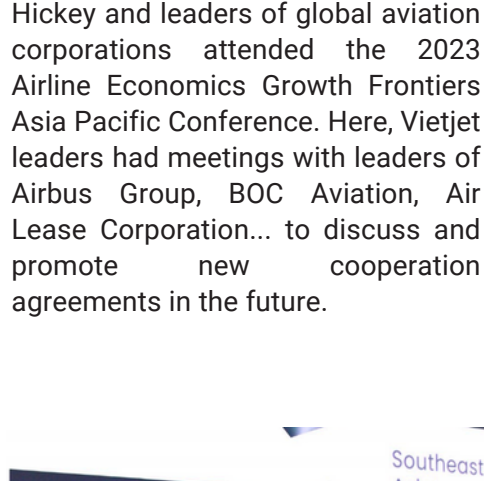

**Party Committee Secretaries of Shanghai and Ho Chi Minh City congratulate Vietjet on the new route connecting the two cities**

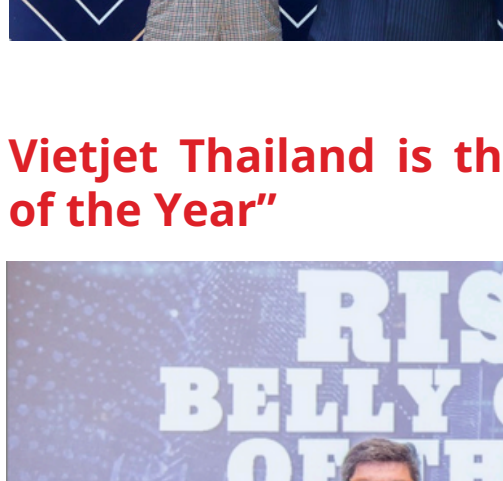

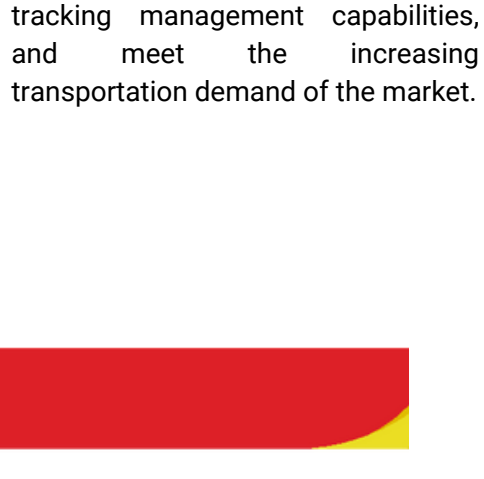

**OPERATION AND TRAINING**

**Ministry of Labor, Invalids and Social Affairs delegation visited Vietjet Aviation Academy**

On November 15, Vietjet was approved by the Civil Aviation Authority of Vietnam to conduct C check for A320/A321 aircraft at the AMO by Vietjet and its Lao partner in Vientiane (Laos). Accordingly, Vietjet continues to record new progress in aircraft repair and maintenance activities, enhance operational efficiency, and continue to develop sustainably.

In addition, from November 16, Vietjet also began testing the Electronic Technical Log Book in some aircraft to reduce data entry and document storage time for engineers and improve efficiency.

On November 17, Vice President To Viet Thang had a meeting with Airbus/Navblue Regional Safety Director - Adrian Abraham to evaluate the effectiveness of coordination in flight safety management in recent times, focusing on flight data program, SMS enhancement, flight safety analysis,... In addition, the meeting also focused on proposing directions and cooperation plans in 2024, to optimize operations efficiency and improve the company's safety indicators.

On November 24, the HODs and training course for 46 MiniMBA and managers officially opened with the goal of developing the company's leadership team. Attending the opening ceremony, CEO Dinh Viet Phung hopes that after completing the course, staff will acquire new and useful knowledge to effectively coordinate and manage work, contributing to Vietjet's development.

**Emergency response practice throughout the company**
