Vietnam Prime Minister Pham Minh Chinh witnessed the announcement of Vietjet's direct route between Hanoi and Jakarta



On September 4, Vietjet announced the service linking Hanoi with Jakarta, the capitals of Vietnam and Indonesia, in the presence of Vietnam's Prime Minister Pham Minh Chinh and the two countries' high ranking leaders and enterprises during the Prime Minister's visit to Indonesia to attend the 43rd ASEAN Summit. The newly announced Hanoi - Jakarta route will be Vietjet's fourth direct service between Vietnam and Indonesia, totaling the flights between the two countries to 92 flights per week starting this December.

Carlyle Aviation Partners, the firm's global aircraft finance and leasing business, have entered into negotiations under a non-binding memorandum of understanding to finance 737 Max aircraft from the order of 200 aircraft between Vietjet and Boeing. This is a significant aircraft order and considered one of the largest commercial contracts and contributes greatly to the trade balance between Vietnam and the United States to date.
