#### Vietjet Receives 10 New Aircrafts This Year



Amidst the global shortage in aviation markets and the rising demand for travel, Vietjet is expected to add 10 new-generation aircraft to its fleet in late 2024. This expansion aims to meet growing development needs and serve customers across domestic and international routes, providing joyful and fulfilling flight experiences with professional, dedicated crews.

The new aircraft, mostly A321neo ACF (Airbus Cabin Flex) from Airbus, are scheduled for delivery starting in August 2024.

Vietjet's fleet of over 100 aircraft with optimized operational costs has helped open up more flying opportunities for customers, protect the environment, and save fuel, all with the goal of achieving net-zero carbon emissions by 2050.

#### IATA Praises Vietjet in IOSA Certification Renewal Process
