Announcement of an order for 20 A330neo aircraft with Airbus

Vietjet and Airbus signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) for the order of 20 A330neo (A330-900) wide bodies. This is Vietjet's largest wide-body aircraft order to date and one of the largest orders at this year's Singapore Airshow.

The new A330neo aircraft is a strategic addition to comprehensively modernize Vietjet's fleet, enhancing operational capabilities to support our global flight network expansion plan. Its fuel-efficient new-generation design aligns with our sustainable development strategy and ESG goals, aiming for net-zero emissions by 2050.

Strategic Partnership with Safran, continuing to expand relationships with international partners

Vietjet and Safran Aerosystems announced a strategic partnership for the supply of safety equipment on Vietjet's B737MAX aircraft. The selection includes essential safety components such as Life Rafts, Protective Breathing Equipment,... and associated support services. At the same time, Safran will also implement an agreement to provide consulting services to support fuel saving and emissions reduction for the airline's fleet.

At the Singapore Airshow, Vietjet had agreements with Thales Group (France) and Collins Aerospace Company (USA) to provide electrical and electronic equipment on the airline's B737 Max aircraft.

Vietjet continues to receive new aircraft on the first days of Lunar New Year

In the exciting early days of new spring, Vietjet has welcomed the 105th aircraft to join its modern fleet, continuing its fleet development plan, meeting all customers' needs.

This aircraft continues to strengthen the modern fleet, ready for the network expansion plans in the new year of Dragon and the next development steps of Vietjet.

Choosing to use Rolls-Royce's Trent 7000 engine for 20 A330neo aircraft

Along with the agreement to order new aircraft, Vietjet and Rolls-Royce Group announced a commitment for 20 Trent 7000 powered A330neo and spare engines, which will complement the airline's existing wide body fleet of seven Trent 700 powered A330ceo aircraft. Trent 7000 engines save fuel up to 14% per seat used and help reduce hundreds of thousands of tons of CO2 emissions over the life cycle of each aircraft.

Pratt & Whitney engines were selected for 19 A321neo aircraft

Vietjet and Pratt & Whitney announced that the airline has exercised for an additional 19 firm GTF-powered A321neo aircraft. Pratt & Whitney will also provide Vietjet with engine maintenance through an engineWise® Comprehensive service agreement. A signing ceremony took place at the Singapore Airshow. Pratt & Whitney engines have the ability to save 15-17% of fuel for aircraft, making an important contribution to Vietjet's sustainable development strategy.

Vietjet jubilantly inaugurated the new route Ho Chi Minh City - Chengdu (China)

On February 10, in the festive atmosphere of Lunar New Year's first day, Vietjet has jubilantly inaugurated the new route Ho Chi Minh City - Chengdu (China), opening up opportunities for easy travel, promoting trade and tourism between Vietnam and China.
