

Sovico, Vietjet, and HDBank expand cooperation with leading U.S. companies



During General Secretary and State President Tô Lâm's official visit to New York, USA, Sovico, Vietjet, and HDBank signed several important agreements with leading U.S. partners, contributing to promoting bilateral economic growth, sustainable development, and affirming the commitment of enterprises from both countries to materializing the Vietnam-U.S. joint declaration.

Chairwoman Dr. Nguyễn Thị Phương Thảo: Turn Vietnam into a global aviation hub



On September 21st, Chairwoman Dr. Nguyễn Thi Phương Thảo, along with Vice President Nguyễn Thanh Sơn, attended a government conference chaired by Prime Minister Pham Minh Chính, discussing solutions to contribute to the country's socio-economic development.

At the conference, Chairwoman Nguyễn Thị Phương Thảo affirmed that the capabilities and innovations of Vietnamese corporations are limitless, urging the Prime Minister to trust in private businesses and create favorable conditions for the establishment of regulations, laws, mechanisms, and environments that would enable domestic companies to form strong national and international brands. These leading corporations, she emphasized, would drive the growth of small and medium enterprises, as well as rural and agricultural sectors, and startups.

Chairwoman Thao also expressed the hope that Vietjet would receive support to invest in and build a robust fleet of Vietnamese aircraft. She applauded the evisa policy that helps aviation quickly attract tourists, traders, and international investors to Vietnam.

She urged businesses to dream big: "Turn Vietnam into a major aviation development hub of the region and the world-a hub for passenger and cargo transportation, aviation technology, training, and aircraft maintenance." Dr. Nguyễn Thị Phương Thảo also reaffirmed her commitment to working together to achieve the growth goals set by the government, emphasizing that Sovico and companies like Vietjet will continue to make persistent efforts and contribute to the rapid and sustainable development of Vietnam's aviation and tourism sectors.

She expressed optimism about a bright future for Vietnam's economy, driven by the pioneering spirit of aviation and tourism enterprises, and encouraged joint action to bring that future closer.

Ongoing international cooperation efforts



Vietjet and Honeywell: Milestone towards green development and clean energy



Vietjet September 23rd, On and Honeywell Aerospace signed cooperation agreement on supplying and electronic equipment aviation technology services for Vietjet's modern, fuel-efficient fleet. The signing ceremony took place in the presence of General Secretary and State President Tô Lâm during his visit to the U.S.

The agreement, signed by CEO Đinh Việt Phương and Mr. Joseph Vitulli, representative of Honeywell, marks a significant step in modernizing Vietjet's fleet with Honeywell avionics and auxiliary power unit (APU) systems for the airline's new wide-body A330neo aircraft and other narrow-body jets. Additionally, Honeywell's Flight Efficiency services will be applied across Vietjet's entire fleet to reduce emissions and save fuel.

Laos Deputy Prime Minister and Foreign Minister highly appreciates Vietjet's role in promoting trade and tourism



On September 12th, during an official visit to Vietnam, Laos Deputy Prime Minister and Foreign Minister Saleumxay Kommasith met with Dr. Nguyễn Thanh Hùng, Vice President Đỗ Xuân Quang, and Vice President Nguyễn Đức Thịnh.

During the meeting, Mr. Saleumxay Kommasith congratulated Vietjet on its impressive growth and recognized the airline's critical role in boosting trade and tourism through flight connections between the two countries and cooperation agreements with the Laos Civil Aviation Authority and Laos Airlines. He, along with the Laos government, committed to supporting Vietjet's expansion of its aircraft maintenance center at Wattay International Airport.

Airbus commits to supporting Vietjet in promoting aviation development



On September 18th, Dr. Nguyễn Thanh Hùng, together with Sovico's working group, met with leaders of the Ministry of Education and Training and RMIT University to promote aviation training cooperation and create opportunities for youth to develop their skills and knowledge. On the same day, Dr. Nguyễn Thanh Hùng also held a meeting with His Highness Sheikh Jassim bin Mansour bin Jabor Al Thani, Director of Qatar's Government Communication Office, to discuss issues in media and international cooperation.

From September 11-13, 2024, at the 2nd Asia-Pacific Aviation Ministers' Meeting, organized by India's Civil Aviation Ministry and the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO), Commercial Director Ta Hữu Thanh participated in discussions with international agency leaders and partners to promote aviation cooperation in the near future.

Welcoming international delegations for visits and discussions



On September 12th, Vice President Tô Việt Thắng met with Ms. Yuli Thompson, Director of IATA Southeast Asia. During the meeting, the two discussed plans and roadmaps for the use of sustainable aviation fuel (SAF) in alignment with Vietjet's commitment to achieving Net Zero by 2050 and its upcoming participation in the Carbon Offsetting and Reduction Scheme for International Aviation (CORSIA) by 2026. They also talked about future operations at Long Thành Airport.

On the same day, Vice President Nguyễn Thanh Sơn welcomed Mr. Uchibori Masao, Governor of Fukushima Prefecture (Japan), and his delegation. Mr. Uchibori praised the role and effectiveness of Vietjet's routes connecting Vietnam and Japan, contributing to trade, economic growth, tourism, and cultural exchanges between the two countries. He expressed hopes for and pledged support for Vietjet to soon open regular flights to Fukushima.

On September 24th, Vice Chairman of the Board Nguyễn Anh Tuấn, Vice President Tô Việt Thắng, and Vice President Lương Thế Phúc welcomed Mr. Paul Meijers. Executive Vice President of Airbus Commercial, and his team.

Mr. Meijers emphasized that Vietjet is one of Airbus's major and important customers, and the cooperation between the two parties is growing stronger. Airbus leadership pledged to continue supporting Vietjet in human resource training, technical maintenance, and fleet expansion, fostering the growth of the aviation industry in Vietnam and globally.
