
Lithuanian President arrived in Hanoi on a Vietjet flight

On June 25, Chairwoman Dr. Nguyen Thi Phuong Thao attended and delivered a speech at the 3rd UNESCO Global Forum on the Ethics of Artificial Intelligence (AI) held in Bangkok, Thailand. The event was attended by Thai Prime Minister Paetongtarn Shinawatra, UNESCO Director General Audrey Azoulay, and over 800 leaders, experts, and scholars from UNESCO's 194 member states.

The Chairwoman said "We must begin with people - upholding equality rooted in dignity and the fundamental right to personal happiness, regardless of background, income, gender, or education level. In this spirit, I believe that in the world of AI, there is no difference between myself - a successful person, a billionaire and a tuk-tuk driver or an ordinary citizen on the street. With that being said, at this prestigious UNESCO forum, I hope we will move beyond viewing AI merely as a tool and instead embrace it as a commitment. A commitment that AI must always return to the heart of humanity, guided by core values: compassion, integrity, and the aspiration to build a world that is fairer, more inclusive, and better for all."

Vietjet expands international cooperation at Paris Airshow 2025, marking a new milestone in its global journey



From June 15 to 20, a Vietjet delegation led by Chairwoman Dr. Nguyen Thi Phuong Thao, Dr. Nguyen Thanh Hung, CEO Dinh Viet Phuong, Independent Director Dr. Philipp Rösler, Member of BOD, Executive Vice President, CFO Ho Ngoc Yen Phuong, Executive Vice President Micheal Hickey, and Executive Vice President To Viet Thang attended the 2025 Paris Airshow at Le Bourget, France. This is the world's largest aviation event, attracting over 2,400 exhibitors from 48 countries. At the event, Vietjet signed several significant agreements and held meetings with leading global aviation partners, marking a new stage in the airline's development and international expansion.

Vietjet orders additional 40 Rolls-Royce Trent 7000 engines

Vietjet has placed an order with Rolls-Royce for additional 40 Trent 7000 engines to power 20 Airbus A330neo aircraft. This follows an order made last year at Singapore Airshow for 40 Trent 7000 engines, taking the order total to 80.

Vietjet selects Honeywell as strategic technical partner for A330 fleet

Vietjet and Honeywell officially announced a cooperation agreement for technical services related to the electrical and electronic systems of the 331-350C auxiliary power units (APUs) installed on Vietjet's Airbus A330 fleet. This agreement affirms Vietjet's strategy to develop its wide-body fleet as part of its ambition to expand further in the global aviation market.

Vietjet signs agreement with Collins Aerospace to enhance A321neo fleet performance

Vietjet and Collins Aerospace have signed a cooperation agreement to provide technical support for Vietjet's A321neo fleet powered by Pratt & Whitney GTF engines. Under the agreement, Collins Aerospace will deliver global maintenance services and OEM-backed technical support for engine accessories.

Vietjet places new order for 100 A321neo aircraft


Vietjet and aircraft manufacturer Airbus announced a major new order for 100 A321neo aircraft, with the potential to add another 50 in the future. The event underscores the growing economic cooperation between Vietnam, France, and Europe. The landmark agreement also represents a significant step in Vietjet's growth strategy as a multi-national aviation group. The latest order follows Vietjet's commitment for 20 additional A330neo aircraft last month, bringing the airline's total wide-body aircraft on order to 40.

Dr. Philipp Rösler - Former German Vice Chancellor joins Vietjet



Vietjet has just approved the election of Mr. Philipp Rösler, former German Vice Chancellor, to the company's Board of Directors for the 2022-2027 term. Dr. Philipp Rösler is a German of Vietnamese descent and has held many important positions in the German government, including: Minister of Health, Minister of Economics and Technology, and Deputy Prime Minister from 2011 to 2013. He is the first person of Asian descent to hold the position of Deputy Prime Minister in German history.

Vietjet attends the 81st IATA Annual General Meeting



From June 1 to 3, Dr. Nguyen Thanh Hung and CEO Dinh Viet Phuong attended the 81st Annual General Meeting (AGM) of the International Air Transport Association (IATA), held in New Delhi, India. The conference focused on discussing key challenges and opportunities, enhancing international cooperation, and shaping sustainable development strategies for the global aviation industry.

AIRLINE NEWS

* In the first half of this year, total passenger traffic at airports nationwide increased, with no serious incidents affecting aviation safety.

* The Deputy Prime Minister has assigned the Ministry of Construction to lead the study of a proposal by Xuan Truong Construction Enterprise to build an international airport at the current location in Y Yen District, Nam Dinh Province.

* The Deputy Prime Minister has proposed adding aviation security regulations for unmanned aerial vehicles (UAVs).

* The Civil Aviation Authority of Vietnam has requested the Ministry of Construction to permit and assign the agency to notify the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) of Vietnam's participation in the voluntary phase of the Carbon Offsetting and Reduction Scheme for International Aviation (CORSA).

* Under the new regulation, provincial People's Committees are authorized to approve investment policies for new airport projects, including airports, runways, and terminals, with a cargo capacity of 1 million tons per year or more.

* Vinh Airport will temporarily close from July until the end of the year for infrastructure repair and upgrade.




Vietjet honored in innovative business and sustainable development

Vietjet launches first-ever direct flights connecting Vietnam and Russia
