**Vietjet advances long-term strategic partnerships with U.S. partners**



On February 18, Vietjet signed several long-term cooperation agreements. These agreements support the airline's fleet development strategy over the coming years, including contracts for engine supply, technical services, and commercial financing in line with international aviation standards. Specifically, Vietjet and Pratt & Whitney signed a memorandum of understanding regarding the provision of engines and technical support services for the A321neo and A321XLR aircraft in the future. This agreement will be implemented in phases, in accordance with the airline's aircraft delivery schedule and operational conditions.

In addition, Vietjet reached a financial cooperation agreement with Griffin Global Asset Management to arrange funding for several Boeing 737-8 aircraft, which will be leased to Thai Vietjet Air (Thai VJC), an affiliated entity of Vietjet.

These partnerships reflect Vietjet's long-term development orientation and strengthen economic, technological, and financial cooperation between Vietnam and the United States in the aviation sector.

**Promoting cooperation with Carlyle Aviation Partners**



On February 26, Chairwoman Dr. Nguyen Thi Phuong Thao met and worked with Mr. Alexander Rasnavad, Chairman of Carlyle Aviation Partners.

Mr. Alexander Rasnavad congratulated Vietjet on its impressive growth achievements and highly appreciated the long-term development potential of the Vietnamese and regional aviation markets. The two sides discussed directions for expanding strategic cooperation and reviewed outstanding results of past collaborations. In particular, the financing agreement to support aircraft purchases for delivery in 2025-2026 has created a solid foundation for both sides to promote deeper and more sustainable cooperation opportunities in the future.

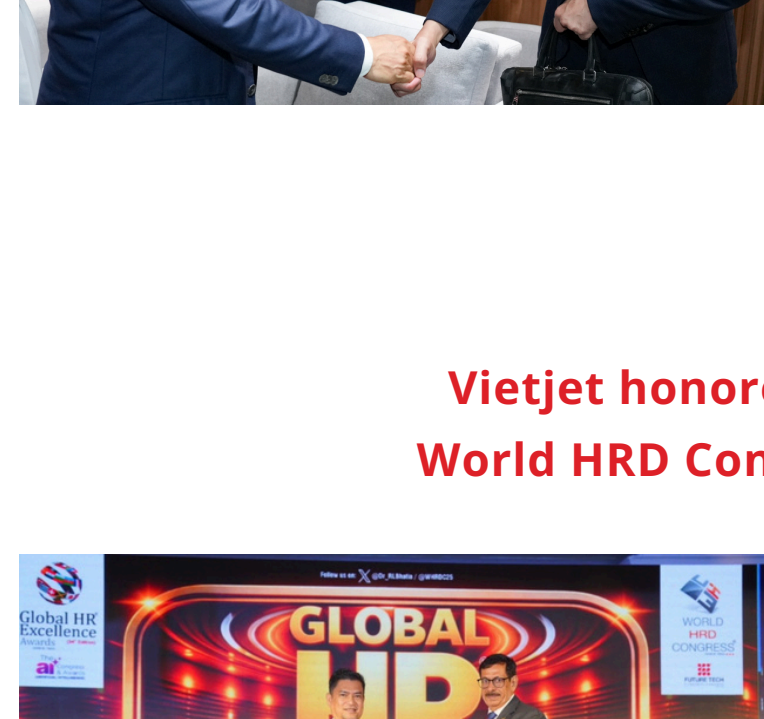
\* According to the Civil Aviation Authority of Vietnam, the draft Decree on flight operations is being developed to concretize the 2025 Law on Civil Aviation of Vietnam, while fully incorporating the standards and recommended practices of the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO).

\* Due to the temporary closure of Lien Khuong Airport for maintenance from March 4, airlines have adjusted schedules and suspended services to and from Da Lat.

\* The Ministry of Construction has approved adjustments to the master plan of Phu Quoc International Airport and ratified the master plan for Da Nang International Airport.

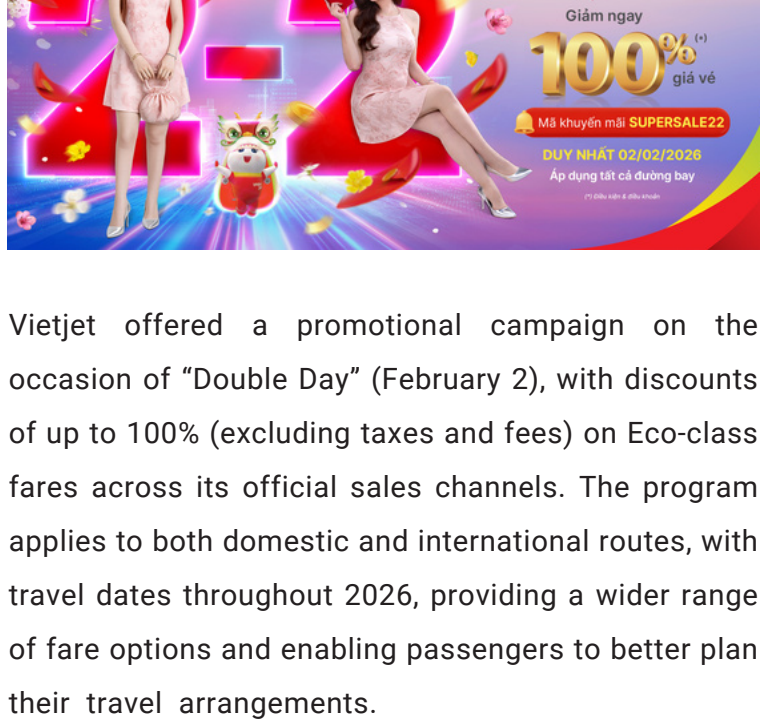
**Enhancing technology application to ensure effective technical maintenance**

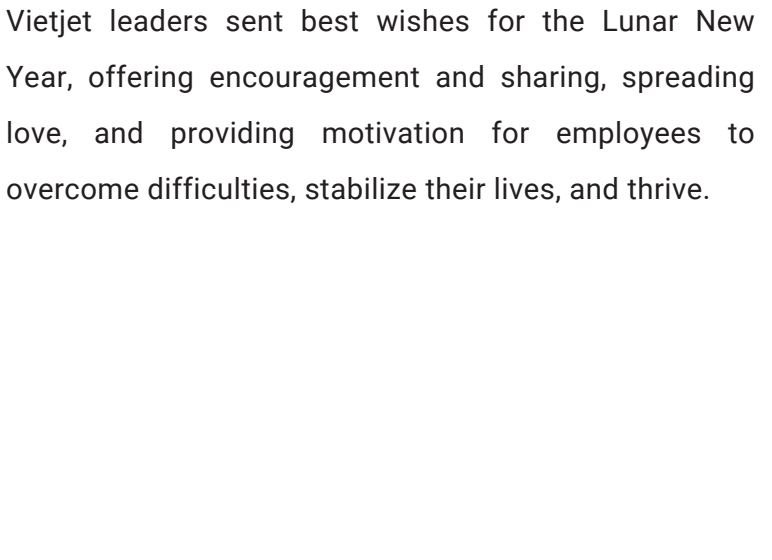

**20kg checked baggage & Phu Quoc accommodation promotion**



Vietjet launched a promotion of 20kg free checked baggage alongside partnered stay packages in Phu Quoc, available from February 5 to 28, 2026 across its official sales channels. Under the program, Eco-class passengers on selected international routes will receive 20kg of free checked baggage for travel between February and March 2026. During the same period, passengers holding a Vietjet boarding pass can enjoy up to 30% off room rates at the airline's partner hotels and resorts in Phu Quoc, applicable for stays in March 2026.
