Vietjet and Sovico Holdings, HDBank honored to hold the Culture Night at Furama to treat all the members of ABAC.

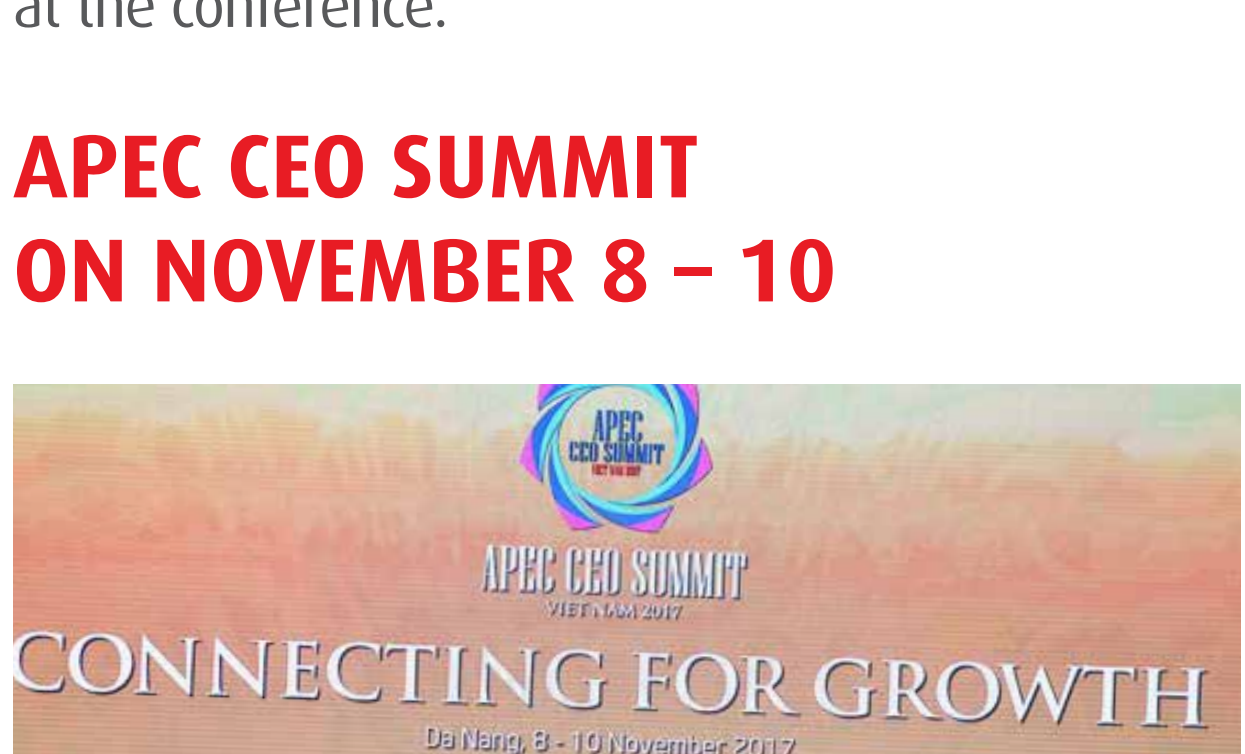
VIETNAM BUSINESS SUMMIT

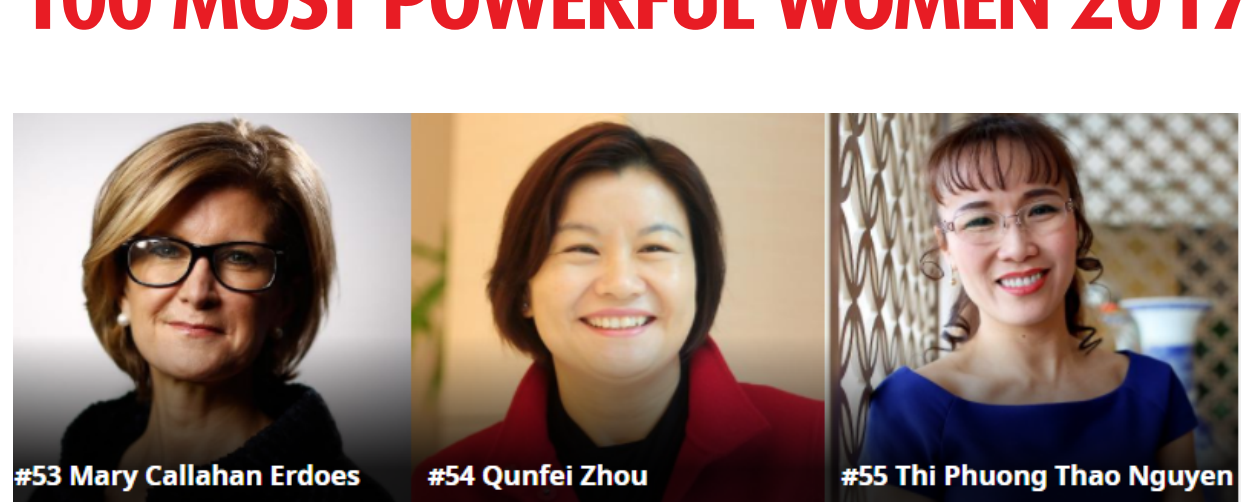

VIETJET'S PROFIT REACHED NEARLY VND3,000 BILLION AFTER 9 MONTHS

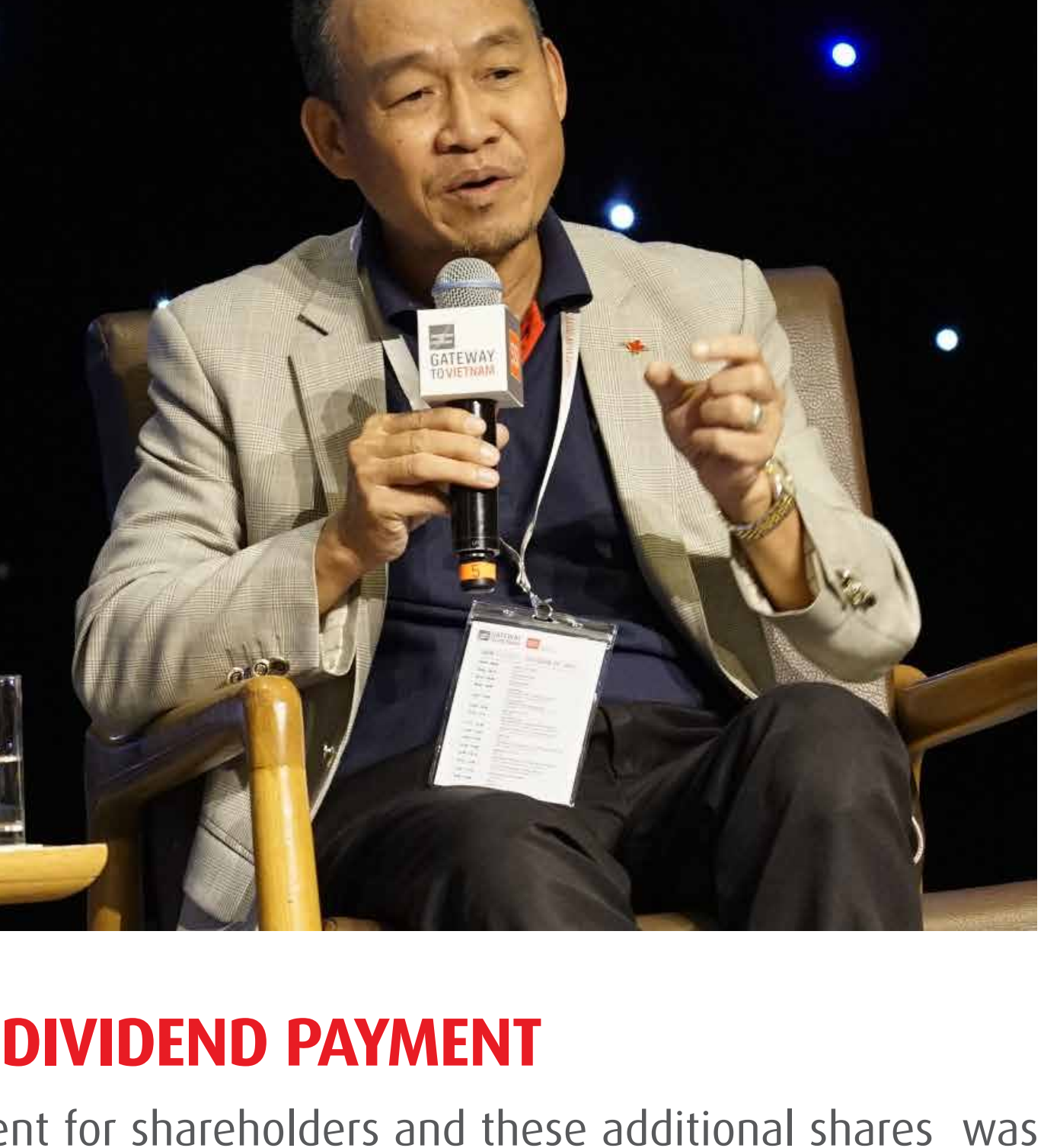
In October, Vietjet announced the financial report of the 3rd quarter and 9 months of 2017 with many positive results.

In the third quarter of 2017, thanks to the expansion of new routes and the operating improvement of existing routes, Vietjet's revenue and profit increased significantly compared to last year's same period and exceeded the plan. Specifically, air transport revenue reached to VND6,142 billion, increased by 34.4% compared to the same period of 2016. Pre-tax profit stood at VND1,054 billion, an increase of 35.1% year on year, 9 month accumulated ones reached to VND2,982 billion. Up to September 30, 2017, Vietjet's total assets stood at VND26,289 billion, an increase of 57.39% year on year. On the first 9 months of this year, taking the delivery of 5 additional airplanes, Vietjet commenced 13 new routes, increased the total number of routes to 73. In particular, there are 38 domestic routes and 35 international ones. The OTP in 9 months was 85.4%. Based on the current business results, Vietjet estimated its pre-tax profit could exceed 10% of the budgeted plan which was approved at the annual shareholder meeting

VIETJET ATTENDED GATEWAY TO VIETNAM 2017 CONFERENCE

Gateway to Vietnam 2017 with themes "Capital Market – A New Driver for Vietnam's Economic Growth" took place in three days 25, 26 and 27/10/2017 in Ho Chi Minh City. The conference which was organized by SSI welcomed hundreds investment funds around the world who wanted to learn investment opportunities as well as the participation of many leading business leaders in Vietnam.

At the meeting, Managing Director Luu Duc Khanh, Vice President To Viet Thang shared Viet Nam's symbolic success story, as well as Vietjet's unique values and cultural identity. Besides, Vietjet also brought a bright picture, showing the development prospects as well as the airline's confidence in the context of global competition.



VIETJET COMPLETED 40% SHARE DIVIDEND PAYMENT

Vietjet completed 40% share dividend payment for shareholders and these additional shares was officially traded on October 27, 2017. After issuing additional shares, Vietjet's total shares trading on the market increased to 451.34 million shares, equivalent to VND4,513 billion on charter capital.

VIETJET WELCOMED MANY INSTITUTION INVESTORS TO FIND INVESTMENT OPPORTUNITIES

Besides meeting analysts, Vietjet's investor relation department met many large institution funds such as Rimrock Capital, Charlemagne, M&G Capital etc. visited and found investment opportunities.

In two months before the peak season, Vietjet focused on maintenance activities, training staff of all departments: operations, engineering, aircraft maintenance, commerce etc. in order to serve the peak season.

Specially, to meet the increasing demands of international and domestic passengers, Vietjet received 7 new Airbus A321 aircrafts and operated them in October and November. Vietjet also officially operated Hanoi – Kaohsiung (Taiwan) route, started selling tickets in two new routes Ho Chi Minh City – Phuket, Ho Chi Minh City – Chiangmai (Thailand) to serve the traveling, trading demands of customers.

Vietjet also assured the security and safety of its all flights during the complicated weather when the Damrey typhoon affected the Central and Central Highlands of Vietnam in early November.

VIETJET THAILAND UNVEILED NEW AIRCRAFT LIVERY TO KICK OFF "THE AMAZING THAILAND TOURISM YEAR 2018"



On November 1, Vietjet Thailand kicked off the "Amazing Thailand Tourism Year 2018 campaign with the unveiling of its new aircraft livery in the witness of Thailand Minister of Tourism and Sports, Ms. Kobkarn Wattanavrangkul and Vietnamese Ambassador in Thailand, Mr. Nguyen Hai Bang.

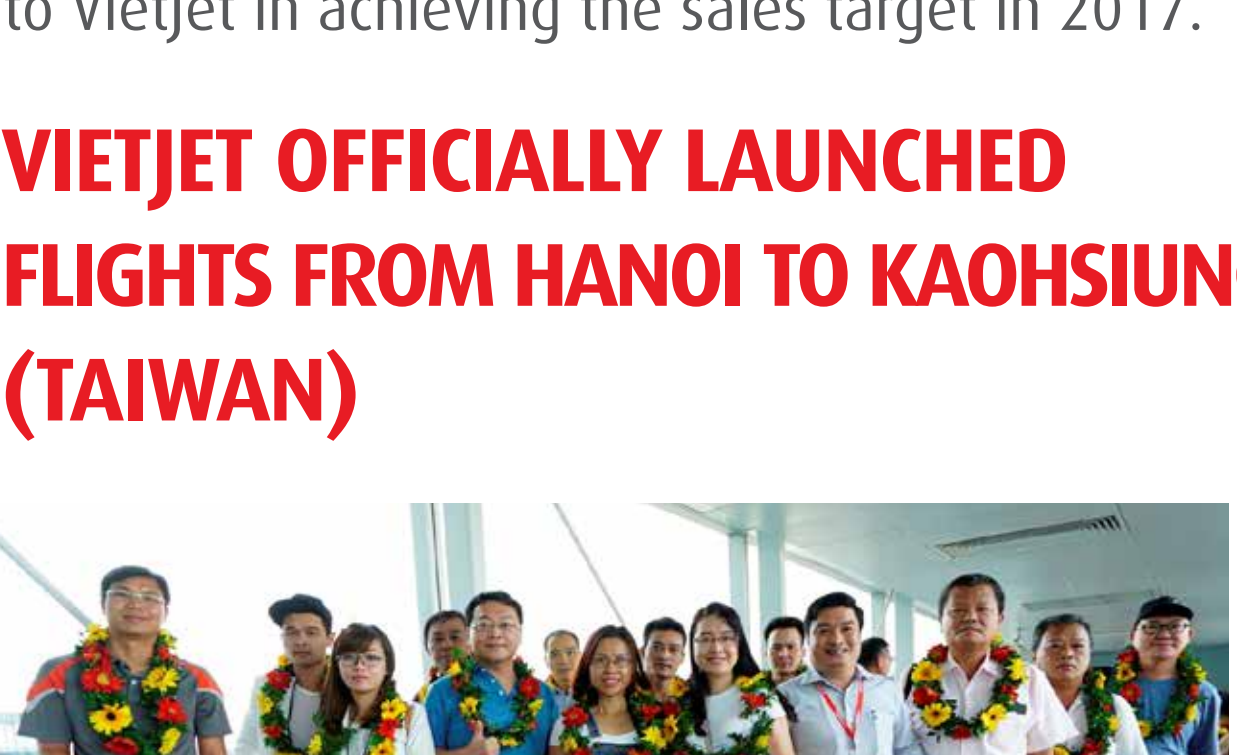
From now until December 31st, 2017, Vietjet and Ho Chi Minh City Development Joint Stock Commercial Bank (HDBank) coordinate to launch a promotional program for new customers and existing Vietjet – HDBank international co-branded credit card holders. During the promotional period, new customers register for an international co-branded credit card and the existing cardholders who purchase flight tickets will be reimbursed 20% (for a maximum amount of VND500,000) and 10% (for a maximum amount of VND200,000) respectively when payments are successfully made via on website www.vietjetair.com. The promotion will be applied for all Vietjet's domestic and international routes.

VIETJET HOT AIR BALLOON AND BIKINI GIRLS LANDED IN AMERICA



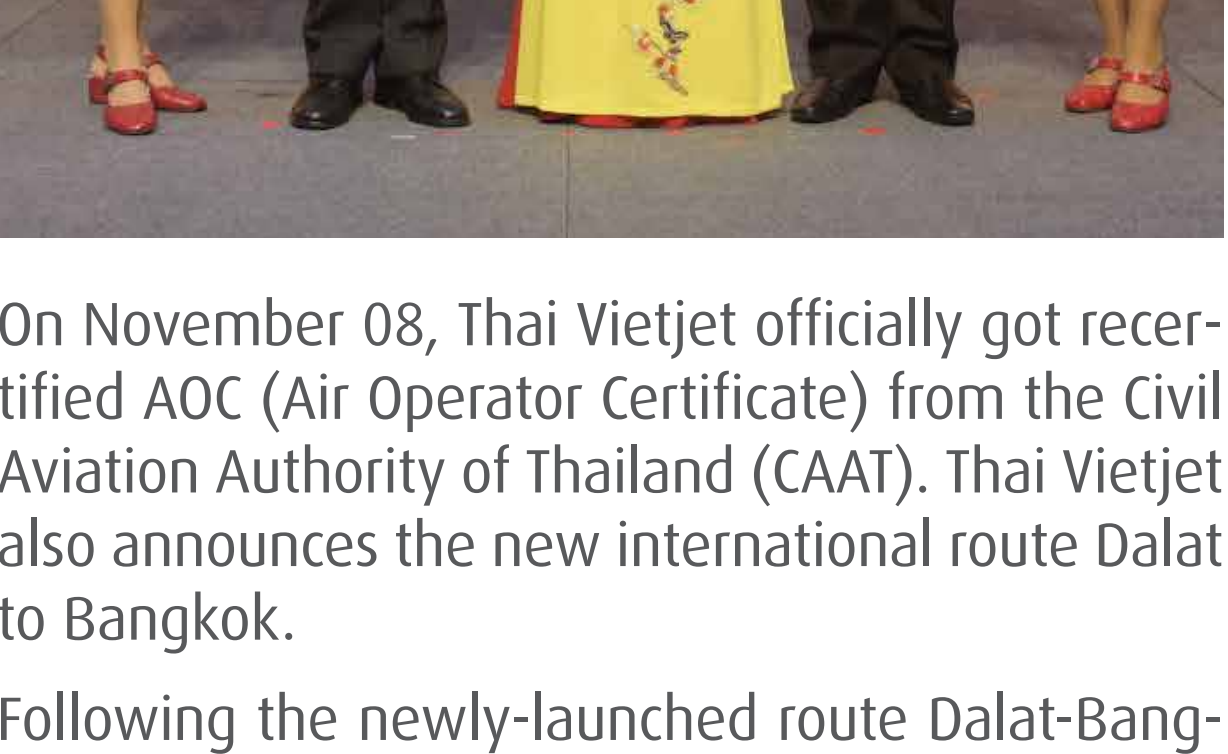
