

Key Highlights

- Carried 4.36 m passengers in Q3 2017, an increase of 25% vs Q3 2016.
- ASK in Q3 2017 is 5,776 m, increased 32,1 % vs Q3 2016
- Fuel price increased 8.6% vs Q3 2016 from 65USD/barrel to 70.59 USD/barrel in Q3 2017


Operating Statistics

- Modern and young fleet with average age of 3.37 years comprising 25 Airbus A320s and 15 A321s as of 30 September 2017.
- ▶ Up to 30 September 2017, VJC has total 219 aircraft on order with Airbus and Boeing in which the company received 27 aircraft.
- Pax Carried: 4.36m passengers in Q3 2017.
- Operated an extensive network of <u>38 domestic routes and 35</u> international routes, excluding charter services up to September 30, 2017.
- Vietjet operated a total of 24,516 flights in Q3 2017.
- Aircraft utilization 14.04 block hours per aircraft a day.
- On-time performance ratio of 85.4% in 9M 2017

Early August, 2017, after exploration and assessing process, the delegation and 4 Vietjet's aircraft departed to Pakistan to operate wet-leased flights.

Fleet Expansion

- Vietjet's aircraft fleet by 30th September, 2017 stood at 40 aircraft including 25 Airbus A320s and 15 Airbus A321s with the average age of 3.37 years.
- The fleet of aircraft has seat configuration from 180 to 220-230 seats and the designs are in tune with the low cost airline business model.
- Vietjet made an order of 119 Airbus A320/321 aircraft and an order of another 100 737MAX 200 aircraft with Boeing.
- The orders with Airbus and Boeing will be completed at the end of 2023.






Safety records among AAPA Airlines members





Best In Class Cost Structure With Room For Improvement




Lowest CASK-Ex fuel. There is still headroom for cost structure improvement to further decrease both CASK & CASK ex-fuel













Best Class In Operating Performance

Solid Growth In Ancillary


- Ancillary revenue per pax: increased 20.7% from 12.1 USD/pax in Q3/2016 to 14.6 USD/pax in Q3/2017.
